Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President David Hays.

- We have 192 current members. **DOOR CARD DOESN'T WORK? YOU HAVEN'T RENEWED YOUR MEMBERSHIP.**
- Connie Crandall, Treasurer, reported that the club made \$2019.05 profit from the Triple Crown. The treasurer's report was reviewed by the attendees. Bob Graham made a motion to accept and it was approved. The letter of approval for 501 c(3) status for the CFA Scholarship Foundation has been received.
- The wooden memory and scholarship plaques have been installed on the wall to the board room entrance. Some name plates have been engraved and additional similar, blank name plates ordered for future engraving.
- Lora Ketterling, Scholarship Chair, reported that 195 of the 200 tickets for the Scholarship Dinner and Auction have been sold. Some donations are still coming in. The range cleanup will be 1 PM Friday with table/chair setup after JOAD Saturday morning. Raffle ticket sellers are needed during the dinner/auction.
- Curt Gowdy S.P. has a new Superintendent. The Outdoor Slam has been cancelled for this year.
- CFA will have to arrange for catering for RMAA and BHW. The previous caterer does not want to do it. Connie suggested we can do it for RMAA.
- Jim Mallon is the new BOW local representative.
- Al Tharp, the local Senior Olympics Point of Contact, said the archery event will be Friday, August 10th from 9 AM to noon at North Park.
- Neal Perkins suggested upgrades to the toilets, such as new towel and soap dispensers. Current features are about 12 years old.
