Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Board President, Greg Wooden.

Treasures report was presented by Board Treasurer, Monica Mallon. Report was reviewed and discussed. Motion to approve-Myron Reed, second-Richard Thompson.

Minutes from the February meeting were presented by Secretary, Judy Wooden. No corrections were needed. Motion to accept-Monica Mallon, second-Jim Mallon.

The CFA Scholarship Foundation are holding a fun shoot on May 7<sup>th</sup> from 9:00am – 12:00pm.

Volunteers are needed to assist kids with shooting or directions, cooking or give directions, and/or registering/selling raffle tickets, etc. They need as much help as they can get to help make this event a success. They could also use any donations for prizes to give away to the kids.

Based on the presentation by Jordan Tarbett and the success of Artic Shoot in Fort Collins, discussion was resumed in reference to updating the shooting rules for Bowhunter Weekend. A proposal was made to allow moveable sights. Maximum 5 pins and quivalizers are allowed. All other restrictions will remain in place. We will create a separate class that allows either slider or fixed sights, Bowhunter Modified. It will be the shooters with fixed pins choice, which class they want to participate. The standard Bowhunter class will remain the same as previous years. Another proposal was made to allow range finders in all classes. Again, it will be the shooters choice to use a range finder or not. After a lengthy discussion, both proposals were approved. Motion was approved by Jennifer and second was made by Monica.

Maximum shot length for Men's classes will by 60 yards. Maximum shot length for Women's classes will be 45 yards.
