Minutes
CFA Annual Meeting
February 8, 2016

The February board meeting was called to order by President, Dan Conrad at 7:00 p.m. Members present were as follows: Robert Graham, Sarah Zacharias, Tim Zacharias, Jared Schinzel, Greg Wooden, Jim Mallon, Gary Cox, Neal Perkins, Myron Reed, Butch Rupert, Stephanie Perkins, Kent Ketterling, Jeremy Cooke, Mike Lancaster, Dan Conrad, Al Tharp, Mary Tharp, and Connie Crandall.

The January Treasurer's report was presented by Mary Tharp for all to review. Bob Graham made a motion to accept the January treasurer's report as presented, Tim Zacharias seconded motion; none opposed, motion carried.

Mary Tharp, Treasurer, presented an overview of income and expenses for the 1st leg of the Triple Crown. Overall profit after expenses was \$1816. We will need to purchase soda and water for concessions, but should have sufficient supply of other items for the 2nd leg this month. We had a profit of \$89 on the Smoker Raffle, \$50 collected on the Metal Detector Raffle which will be given away after the 3rd leg of Triple Crown, and \$55 in t-shirt sales.

Old Business

Trad Shoot/garage sale is May 21, 2016.

Dan had good feedback from shooters regarding the change to Saturday/Sunday shoot times for next year's triple crown.

Tim Zacharias reported that the expansion project committee - Neal Perkins, Tim and Sarah Zacharias, and Danny Simonson – had not met yet. However, Easton has both building and equipment grants available and he hoped to get started working on the equipment grant soon.

The Scholarship Fund Committee – Lora Ketterling, Sarah Zacharias, Jared Schinzel, and Connie Crandall – will meet following the board meeting.

Roll of the CD's has been completed. In addition, the signature cards for the CD's were corrected to require all four board members signatures.

Jeremy Cooke was able to get samples of the club polo shirts and two club hats. A sign up sheet was started at the January Triple Crown Shoot for orders.

Removal of the spotlights and replacement with vinyl elk and roadrunner signs has not been completed. Dan Conrad received a suggestion to put the original roadrunner in the middle with the elk and new roadrunner on each side. The reason for moving the signs was to avoid having them shot up. Bob Graham will schedule the removal and replacement.

New Business

Mary Tharp will not be available between 9-2 on Saturday of the February leg of Triple Crown. Due to the computer problems experienced at the January leg, Butch Rupert made the suggestion to print scorecards for all shooters from the first round. As the shooters register they will receive the pre-printed score card. Only new shooters will need to be entered and printed.

Several requests were made for double scoring at the Triple Crown. Mary Tharp will create new score cards with 36 targets similar to the BHW blue cards.

Gary Cox – The website will be updated with Blue Face scores this week. Dan Conrad also requested removal of the restriction on back facing bars in the Club Rules on the website.

Jim Mallon – Donation to Bowhunters Of Wyoming in the amount of \$150 as approved in the budget is needed for the annual banquet on March 19, 2016.

Bob Graham noted the Club sign on Pershing needs to be redone and/or replaced. Connie Crandall is working on getting a metal reflective sign donated.

Sarah Zacharias – Need a reminder put on Facebook that food is available for purchase at Triple Crown. Dan Conrad will include a reminder when he posts the reminder for the shoot.

Stephanie Perkins – Giving from the Heart presentation is Friday, February 12, 2016 at 7:30 am at the bank. Dan Conrad and Al Tharp will attend to accept the \$500 donation from the bank. The bank will receive two free memberships for this donation per the Club rules.

JOAD – Kent Ketterling – With the expanded time JOAD now has two sessions. Separating the kids has been extremely beneficial as it allows more time to be spent with the younger kids who need more help.

Jeremy Cooke – Buckles will be the same as last time with no date. After discussion, Jeremy will place a shirt/hat order now so that the shirts will be available for pick up at the February leg of the Triple Crown. A suggestion was made that the Board and Officers shirts be a separate color and therefore they will be royal blue. A list of all Officers and Board Members with shirt sizes was given to Jeremy. BHW t-shirts will be revised to have the arrows crossed above the skull rather than running through the eye sockets. Currently plan on ordering only short sleeved, however a later discussion will be held on ordering long sleeved as well.

Jeremy asked if a raffle item had been selected or purchased for the second leg of the Triple Crown. As nothing had been discussed Jeremy suggested a Power Charger/Jump Starter which costs approximately \$160. Motion to have Jeremy Cooke purchase the power charger/jump starter for the 2nd Leg TC Raffle was made by Connie Crandall, Bob Graham seconded; none opposed, motion carried.

Al Tharp – February 9 & 11 will be the last week for Tues-Thurs league payback. Too much hassle to keep track of and the people who wanted it don't participate. Tuesday-Thursday league will continue without payback.
