Minutes from 07/08/2019

Attendance: Robert Graham, Chris Moody, Cleata Zelenka, Mike Lancaster, Kelly Thornbury, Richard Thompson, Al Tharp, Mary Tharp, Mat Rusk, Neal Perkins, Greg Wooden, Kent Ketterling, Kayla Ketterling, Lora Ketterling, David Zelenka, Gary Cox.
Meeting called to order at 7:02 PM by President Bob Graham.

- We have 221 current members.
- Minutes from the June 10th board meeting were summarized by Gary. Neal was recognized and noted BHW food vendor is "Butler Dogs", as opposed to "Burt's Dogs" in June minutes. Richard was recognized and made a motion to accept minutes; Chris seconded. All voted yes.
- Cleata submitted a written preliminary summary of accounts. Her and Mary have gone through 2017-2018. Bob said they are not trying to "find fault", just become familiar with the accounts. Cleata is entering the accounts in QuickBooks. We have \$9900 in ANB checking account and about \$2500 will be used for BHW. Mary suggested changing the bylaws and having annual Dec. audits, so a report can be given at the Jan. meeting. This change needs to be put in the Nov. and Dec. newsletters. Bob suggested going back to Julie Woods, our previous CPA. Mat made a motion to accept treasurer's report; Chris seconded. None opposed.
- Bob commended Cleata for getting our Prudential liability insurance renewed on short notice.
- Bob will be meeting with Curt Gowdy's supervisor to tell him where we are going to set up BHW targets and where to close off biker access.
- Neal was recognized and said the 4H would like to make Curt Gowdy range maintenance a volunteer project. Neal said Butler Dogs, the BHW food vendor, will turn in paperwork to state. They will only be at BHW late Sat. and Sun. mornings. CFA will need to provide something earlier (coffee, doughnuts).
- **BHW setup will be at Aspen Grove, 8 AM Friday Aug. 2nd. A work party at the club for loading the targets, etc. will be at 6:30 PM Tues. July 16th.**
- Mike was recognized and said the Rules and Class Definitions for BHW and Triple Crown are finalized. Those registering at BHW need to be told of the new rules. Printed copies will be available at BHW. See <http://www.cheyennefieldarchers.com/pdfs/BHW%20Rules%20and%20Class%20Definitions.pdf>
- Al was recognized and recommended that the BHW pro shooters should start the course at targets 1 thru 3 to avoid groups bunching up. Motion was made to accept by Mat and seconded by Richard. None opposed. Al said Senior Olympics entries need to be in by Jul. 19th. Also, on the targets for that event 6 cores need to be replaced. We have 7 new ones.

- Outdoor Adventures Program will be from 8 AM to noon, Thur. 18th and Fri. 19th. David Contreras, City Rec., needs to supply CFA certificate of liability insurance. [Gary emailed him July 11th and he supplied a general certificate same day.]
- Lora gave the secretary a listing of the 2019-2020 CFA Scholarship Foundation recipients (See below).
- WSAA's trailer will be stored at the club after Senior Olympics until the state tournament. Club needs to confirm WSAA has insurance on trailer. [Email sent to Bill Heinke by secretary 7/12th]
- Neal was recognized and stated the Governor is going to declare Sept. Archery Month. A ceremony will be held at the Kendrick Gallery Carriage House, across from the State Capitol, at 9:30 AM, Sept. 4th. All archers are welcome to attend.
- Rocky Mountain T-Shirts, of Laramie, will make the BHW shirts. Light gray was chosen for the color with road runner logo on front and elk logo on back. There will be no mention of year or BHW number. There is \$400 budgeted and the number of sizes will be the same as last year, which sold out fast.
- Bob suggested buying a voice recorder for the secretary to record board meetings. Motion was made by Richard and seconded by Mat. None opposed. Secretary will research them, then buy one.
- Cleata suggested Gist may be able to re-tool the club's unused buckles. She will contact Gist, who is doing this year's BHW buckles, which have been ordered.
- A motion was made by Richard, seconded by Mat, to round the Access Yes check up to \$700 from a \$600+ figure. Neal recommended that the shoot should be moved to December to not conflict with other Spring events.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:32 PM. Mat made motion and Kelly seconded.

 Use of verifier peeps will be allowed in all classes that allow sights.

Targets:

Max distance: 50 yards
 1 arrow scoring: 12 - 10 - 8 - 5
 40 unmarked targets each day with a shotgun start on Sunday.
 All classes will shoot with their competition on Sunday.
 Youth and Cubs will shoot all 40 targets Saturday for competition score. (Sunday shoot for fun only.)

FLIGHTING:

Saturday's score is used to determine which flight you shoot in on Sunday. All shooters in a particular flight start out even on Sunday. Sunday scores determine the overall winner each age group/class and flight.

(Cubs and Youth use Saturday scores only)

Adult classes will be awarded with a Gist silversmith belt buckle. Must have at least 2 shooters per class to qualify for buckle. Raffles on site, food is available on site. Novelty shoots Saturday afternoon, look for times.
