Minutes from 06/10/2019

Attendance: Robert Graham, Chris Moody, Connie Crandall, Mike Lancaster, Kelly Thornbury, Richard Thompson, Al Tharp, Kent Ketterling, Kayla Ketterling, Rob Sherman, Dan Conrad, Cleata Zelenka, David Zelenka, Gary Cox.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Bob Graham.

- We have 217 current members.
- Minutes from the May 20th board meeting was read by the secretary and accepted.
- Connie's treasurer report was submitted, although not reconciled with a recent Bullseye Archery purchase of cores. She then submitted her letter of resignation. Upon standing, Bob asked Connie to be seated, but she refused. Bob then asked her to leave and she was escorted to the door. Bob stated that we were there to promote archery and not for disturbances. [See special message on Page 3]
- The Bullseye purchase for target cores was \$4329. An invoice was given and a check written. Bullseye's price was \$160 less than Reinhart's bid. Reinhart cannot sell at wholesale prices to non-distributors. During the May board meeting, Bob, Chris and Neal Perkins discussed purchasing the cores. It was voted and accepted to purchase from the cheaper bidder.
- Bob introduced Cleata Zelenka and her husband David. Cleata has volunteered to be the new treasurer. She will be assisted by Mary Tharp. Bob suggested an audit of the books. A motion was made (Gary, Chris) and accepted. Cleata, Lora Ketterling and Mary Tharp will audit.
- Dan Conrad gave a presentation on having a championship class at BHW and read a letter for soliciting donations. Dan will act as chairman. Seed money has already been donated and Mac Wilson will be the sponsor. After a discussion, it was agreed again that there will only be one course. There will be separate stakes and known yardage (60 yd. max) for the championship shooters. Shooters will be charged \$75 with \$25 going to the club.
- Bob recently repaired a dozen holes in the roof. It was recommended that signs be put up cautioning against "sky drawing". The club also recently incurred water damage from melting hail. Al discovered the water in the club and cleaned it up. Bob suggested removing a dirt pile next to the building and replacing it with crushed granite and kill cloth.
- Buckles and give-away door pins need to be ordered for BHW.
- Burt's Hotdogs has offered to provide food at BHW, but they need us to check which permits are needed from the state.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:05 PM.

SENIOR BHFS.....(Fixed pins, release aid, 12" stabilizer)
TRADITIONAL.....(Recurve/LB, no sights, finger release)
SENIOR.....(Open and Traditional)
HUNTER CLASS.....(NOPAYBACK)

17 years old and younger

YOUNG ADULT MALE/FEMALE.....(15 - 17)
YOUTH MALE/FEMALE.....(12 - 14)
CUBS BOYS/GIRLS.....(11 - younger)

NO Alcoholic beverages may be carried or consumed on course, range or practice area during shooting hours.
NO CROSSBOWS OR RANGEFINDERS - RANDOM SPEED CHECK - 300 fps +/-3%
Use of ventier peeps will be allowed in all classes that allow sights.

Targets:

Max distance: 50 yards
1 arrow scoring: 12 - 10 - 8 - 5
40 unmarked targets each day with a shotgun start on Sunday.
All classes will shoot with their competition on Sunday.
Youth and Cubs will shoot all 40 targets Saturday for competition score. (Sunday shoot for fun only.)

FLIGHTING:

Saturday's score is used to determine which flight you shoot in on Sunday. All shooters in a particular flight start out even on Sunday. Sunday scores determine the overall winner each age group/class and flight.
(Cubs and Youth use Saturday scores only)

Adult classes will be awarded with a Gist silversmith belt buckle. Must have at least 2 shooters per class to qualify for buckle. Raffles on site, food is available on site. Novelty shoots Saturday afternoon, look for times.
