We also held a discussion about the current board officers and the fact that all four are stepping down at the end of the year and we need to find new officers for 2023. We would no longer be able to hold the Triple Crown or Bowhunter Weekend. We would not have anyone to organize those events or all the other programs we support throughout the year.
