Minutes
CFA Monthly Meeting
March 14, 2016

The March board meeting was called to order by President, Dan Conrad at 7:02 p.m. Members present were as follows: Tim Zacharias, Jim Mallon, Myron Reed, Butch Rupert, Kent Ketterling, Mike Lancaster, Dan Conrad, Al Tharp, Mary Tharp, and Connie Crandall.

The February Treasurer's report was presented by Mary Tharp for all to review. Tim Zacharias made a motion to accept the February treasurer's report as presented, Jim Mallon seconded motion; none opposed, motion carried.

Mary Tharp, Treasurer, presented an overview of income and expenses for the 2nd leg of the Triple Crown. Although there was a different configuration of shooters, there was the same number of shooters at the second leg as the first leg (60). Overall profit after payout was \$1959.60. We will need to purchase soda and water for concessions, but should have sufficient supply of other items for the 3rd leg. We had a profit of \$40 on concessions; \$1 on the Power Unit; and \$22 was collected and added to the \$50 from leg 1 on the Metal Detector Raffle to be given away after the 3rd leg of Triple Crown.

Old Business

Trad Shoot/garage sale is May 21, 2016.

Scholarship shoot is April 12 & 14, 2016.

Access Yes shoot is May 10 & 12, 2016

Removal of the spotlights and replacement with vinyl elk and roadrunner signs has not been completed. Dan Conrad received a suggestion to put the original roadrunner in the middle with the elk and new roadrunner on each side. The reason for moving the signs was to avoid having them shot up. Bob Graham will schedule the removal and replacement.

Pre-printed score cards and double scoring worked very well and will be used again for the second leg of the Triple Crown. Thank you **Butch Rupert** for the suggestion on preprinting the score cards. The registration process was much smoother and a whole lot less stressful!!

Connie Crandall is still working on getting a metal reflective sign donated. Should be available soon.

Dan Conrad and Al Tharp accepted the Giving from the Heart \$500 donation from the bank on Friday, February 12, 2016.

Officer phone numbers were added to the newsletter and website in February.

New Business

Al and Mary Tharp donated a used refrigerator to replace the old one which was not cooling properly. Thank you!!

Mary Tharp - Requested permission to borrow the bows for the boy scouts on April 1 & 2. Permission was granted with no opposition.

Butch Rupert

- Requested update on when the new bow press would be set up in the office for use. Mary Tharp and Mike Lancaster will work on getting the table on the north wall and/or the bookshelves on the east wall cleaned and moved so the press can be set up.
- Butch Rupert's daughter quoted a price on the polo shirts with embroidery at \$15 per shirt rather than the \$30 per shirt we purchased prior. She would charge \$25-\$50 for the digitized images and the club would then own the images. Butch has a catalog with the same shirts and also t-shirts. We will contact Jeremy to see if we can get the images.
- Butch suggested we spray foam insulation in the target shed and put electric in the shed so we can keep the targets heated in the winter. Suggested we clean the garage and then spray. Al Tharp or Bob Graham will get an estimate on cost.
- RMAA shoot is June 26. Park vendor will have first refusal on food service. Dan Conrad will be meeting with RMAA prior to the shoot.
- Need to level and haul in rock or recycled asphalt, or pave parking lot. Estimates on grading, recycled asphalt, and pavement are being acquired.
- Butch suggested we contact High West Energy to inquire about "yard" lights in the parking lot.

Connie Crandall – Scholarship Fund Update

- Application has been delivered to the local high schools, emailed to the membership, and is available on the web page.
- Shoot will consist of two rounds of 12 targets. Pledge sheets are available at the Club with a per point or flat donation option.
- Fun shoots will consist of the card shoot, pingpong ball shoot, and clay target shoot.
- Al Tharp suggested we contact Rick Parish at the IKON center for golf/swim passes for door prizes. We will visit other businesses for donations as well.
- We will contact Channel 5 and local radio for advertising; also traders and Tribune.

Mary Tharp will be doing final analysis and recommendation to transfer funds from the checking account to CD or savings in April.

Mary Tharp requested a reminder to fill out pre-registration forms be placed on the web page and social media to save time registering for the Triple Crown.

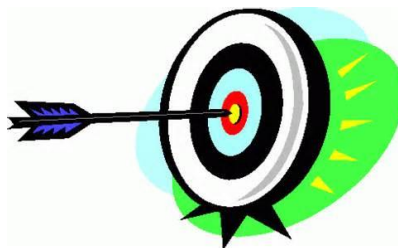
