Minutes of 03-12-2018

Meeting Called to order at 6:59 pm

Treasurers Report was presented by Connie Crandall. A motion to accept the treasurer's report as read by Bob Graham, Second by Myron Reed.

Old Business:

The CFA held the state indoor on March 3rd and 4th, 2018.

The popcorn popper has been purchased and used at Triple Crown, the blue face shoot and state indoor.

New Business:

Connie increased the amount of coverage on building and contents to cover what we currently have collected and stored.

Mark Gaskill made a proposal to the board to write grants for the club. The decision will be made on or before next board meeting to work with Mark on writing grants for the CFA.

Kelly Thornbury wanted to know if we could add yardage markers to the floor. Due to the nature of our 3D shoots that do not allow range finders and are unmarked yardage it was determined that would not work.

Robert Graham brought in 2 proposals for adding additional storage to the existing facility. Because of the lack of land around the club building adding on to the existing garage would only be a stop gap until we out grow that also. After a short discussion another option for short term storage was purchasing a storage pod or movable shed.

The WSAA state Vegas shoot will be held in Cheyenne at the CFA indoor range on February 2nd and 3rd, 2019.

Wyoming State Parks outdoor summer slam is June 2 at Curt Gowdy. Volunteers are needed to man the Clubs booth and work with young archers.

Recipes

Elephant Stew:

1 medium sized elephant (African are best)
500 bushels potatoes
200 bushels carrots
250 bushels tomatoes
2 wheelbarrows onions (heaped)
100 lbs. salt
100 lbs. pepper
10 qts. Vinegar
1500 gallons brown gravy
3000 sprigs parsley

Cut elephant into bite sized pieces (this will take about 2 months).

Cut vegetables into cubes (another 2 months).

Place meat in pan, cover with the brown gravy and simmer for 4 weeks.

Add the salt and pepper to taste.

When the meat is tender, add the vegetables. Simmer for another 4 weeks.

Garnish with parsley.

This will serve 3800 people, but if more are expected, add 2 rabbits. This is optional, as many people dislike finding a hare in their stew.
