Curt Gowdy is hosting a youth event on June 6th & 7th. They asked if CFA might help out with an archery event

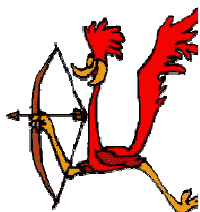

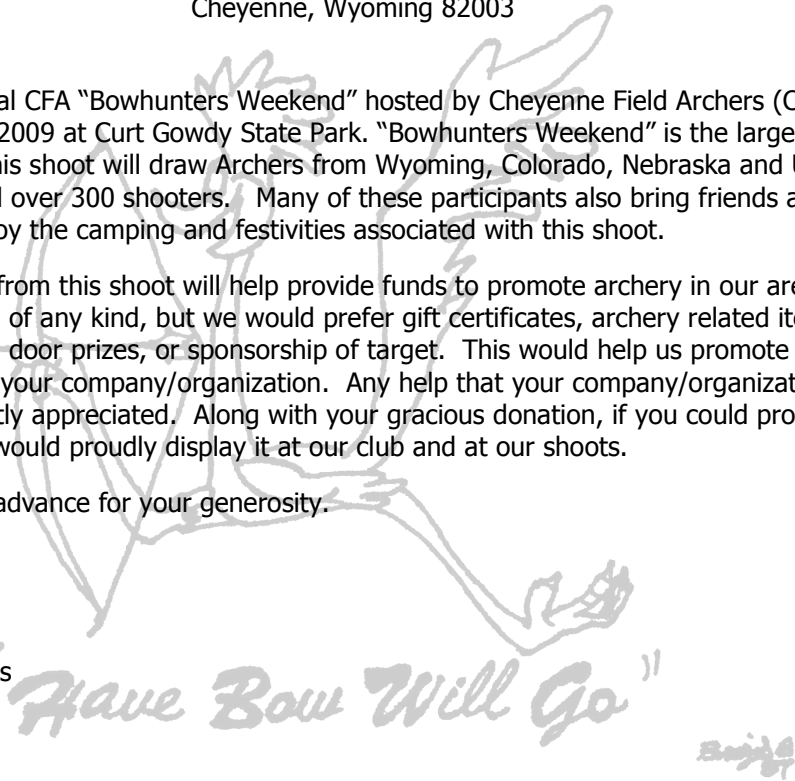
