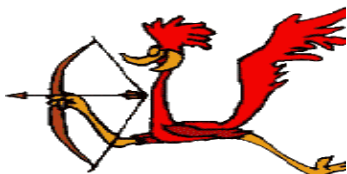

Alta Vista NASP Request-Gene Painter reported to Bob Day that he has been in the club when the kids from Alta Vista have been here and they were very well behaved. Bob reported that the parents signed waivers. The kids will be going to Louisville to compete in NASP nationals.

Wall Extension-final cost was \$363.14 which was less than the original bid of \$409.00. Jim Fraundenlist donated a whole day from his company instead of the ½ day he originally committed to.

Tuesday Leagues will continue – until interest wanes.

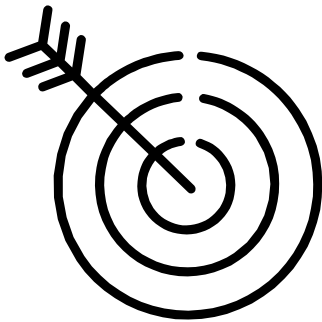
New Office Desk-Bob Graham has a new office desk that was donated by Jonas Bank.

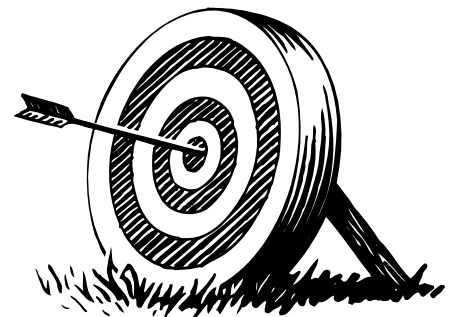

Other Business

Fun Leagues-There was a rather heated discussion about the quality of the cores used for the fun leagues, especially the Tuesday night shoots. Al Tharp who runs the Tuesday night league reported that Neal Perkins and he replaced a lot of the cores in the 3D animals that were being used. That the quality of the cores were not an issue. Rick Ginter said that 25% of the leagues should be used for replacement of the cores. Al Tharp said that he has replaced more than that. He also stated that the cores having two targets, that they might have been shooting at the back target rather than the front. If this was the case, he put brown tape over the target not to be shot. It was recommended by Jim Fraundel that we find a fluorescent orange mesh to cover the target not to be shot.

Adjournment-Bob Graham motioned that the meeting be adjourned, Al Tharp seconded it. The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 pm.
