Minutes from October 14, 2019

Attendance: Richard Thompson, Greg Wooden, Kelly Thornberry, Rob Sherman, Mike Lancaster, Dan Conrad, Gary Cox, Kent Ketterling, Kayla Ketterling, Lora Ketterling, Robert Graham, Cleata Zelenka, Amy Porter, Wyatt Porter, Neal Perkins, Danny Simonson, Jim Mallon, Charles Hersch, Mary Tharp, Al Tharp, Wow!—would have thought free food being served.

Meeting called to order at 7:01pm by President Bob Graham.

- We have 236 current members.
- Minutes from the August 12th board meeting were summarized by Gary. Motion made to accept minutes by Mary; Richard seconded. No opposed.
- Cleata handed out copies of latest balances. We had \$7112.34 income in Aug, mainly due to BHW and memberships. Expenditures were \$3774.74. Main checking wound up with \$10,339.76. Normally, we pay HighWest Energy prorated \$80 monthly for utilities. In Sept. the bill was \$1500. From now on the monthly bill will be about \$200. Several mentioned parking lot lights running 24/7, which costs \$80 monthly. Neal asked how club was doing financially floating or sinking. Cleata and Mary will work up profit-loss spreadsheet for Jan. thru Sept. Property taxes of \$800 due in Nov and will be paid in full. There was a a lot of additional discussion about club's financial status. Motion to accept treasurer's report by Kelly, Dan seconded. None opposed.
- Kelly and Mary will get Triple Crown tasks list and distribute Neal & Amy will try to get sponsor(s) for adult buckles for Triple Crown and BHW. Capitol Lumber has paid for youth buckles Club has enough cub buckles on hand. Neal suggested members present get sponsor(s) for events. Club will put donor names on banner. Donation of \$250 or more gets free membership. Volunteers need donation letters to hand out, in addition to event flyers.
- New business: Bob proposed to raise annual membership fee by \$5, which is an increase of 1 ½ cents per day. See Survey Page 3. Neal said membership fees don't cover keeping club open; need leagues and tournaments to bring in money. Amy said getting enough sponsor money would eliminate the need to raise memberships. Mike said any fee increase must be brought up at annual meeting and needs to be in newsletter each two months before meeting. Also, at the annual meeting Mary said we need a Bylaws change for approval to move money into various accounts, i.e. savings.
- Mary said the DVR has "issues"; not sure if it is hardware or software. Greg will get prices/bids for new DVR and 6-8 video cameras.
- Dan has been questioned about shoot schedule. Rest of meeting was devoted setting shoot & event dates through next May. See Page 2.
- Motion to adjourn at 8:38 PM by Richard; seconded by Kelly.
