**FEES**

**Tumbleweed JOAD club dues for one participant are \$35.00 per season. Additional family members are \$25.00 each.** The Cheyenne Field Archers club charges a range fee of \$2.00 for all non-members per week including JOAD participants. **We encourage you to join Cheyenne Field Archers as the cost is minimal. Dues are \$20.00 per year for a Youth Membership, or \$55.00 per year for a Family Membership.** There is an initiation fee of \$10.00 for Youth or \$50.00 for Family for the first year only. Tumbleweed JOAD is a part of the USA Archery organization. For our shooters to move past the rank of Bowman, they **must** be a member of USA Archery. ## TUMBLEWEED JOAD SAFETY AND COURTESY RULES

- 1. Horseplay WILL NOT be tolerated.** Bows can be dangerous weapons and will be treated as such.
- 2. Running is not allowed.**
- 3. Arrows will remain in a quiver unless being shot.**
- 4. Do not pull the string of a bow and release it unless you are shooting an arrow.** Dry firing a bow can cause severe damage.
- 5. Never touch another person's equipment without permission.**
- 6. If using club equipment, only use what has been assigned to you.**
- 7. Only one person at a time will pull arrows from a target.** Those waiting to pull must stand at least 6 feet from the target.
- 8. If someone is down range, all arrows must be immediately placed in a quiver.**
- 9. Archers not shooting must remain six feet or more behind the shooting line.**
- 10. Archery practice requires concentration. Distracting other archers directly, or indirectly, is not acceptable behavior.** Talking on the shooting line should only take place between shooters and coaches, or shooters and parents. To have quiet conversation, shooters should move to the back of the range.
- 11. Never approach or leave the shooting line when the person on either side of you is at full draw.**
- 12. Negative comments or teasing of other club members is not allowed.**
- 13. Water is to be the only drink used during practice.**

**Violation** of these rules will result in:

1<sup>st</sup> violation – coaches will issue a warning,

2<sup>nd</sup> violation – shooter will sit out the remainder of the session.

Continued violation of these rules from week to week may result in expulsion of the shooter from the JOAD program at the discretion of the coaches.
